

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to make Christmas tree permits available to reservation residents, and

WHEREAS, reservation permits are authorized to be sold for \$1.00 each, limit of one each, for residents, tribal and bureau employees, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman is authorized to issue permits to the traditional users as churches, schools and others as deemed suitable by the Chairman, and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company and Apache Enterprise is authorized to grant Christmas trees to preferred customers, and

WHEREAS, Apache Enterprise is authorized to place a sale at their selected sale lots, Christmas trees.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that one each permit be made available for reservation residents, tribal members to have free use, Fort Apache Timber Company and Apache Enterprise be authorized to utilize.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be granted authority to sign permits for donations of trees at his discretion.

The foregoing resolution was on November 19, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
