



RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Project Apache has been in operation for a period of five (5) years,
 and

WHEREAS, Project Apache is assisting the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the
 maternal and child health program, and

WHEREAS, Project Apache is currently administered under contract to Good Samaritan
 Hospital, and

WHEREAS, this contract will terminate in June, 1976, and

WHEREAS, there is no way of continuing this program under this organization
 because the Department of Health, Education and Welfare will no longer
 award contracts to non-University Institutions.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Project
 Apache apply for operating monies through the rural health program from
 the Bureau of Community Health Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that type
 of program and services continued by Project Apache is in great need for
 the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe request
 that every effort be made to secure operating monies to retain the services
 and program of the Apache Project.

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9
 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,
 pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended
 Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and
 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16
 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
