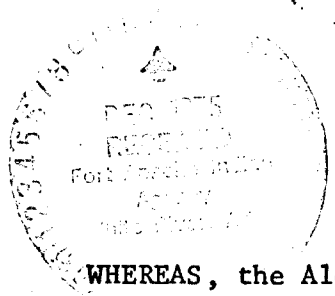


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION



WHEREAS, the Alchesay High School, District No. 20, Whiteriver, Navajo County, Arizona, has consummated an application for sufficient funds to construct a new, much needed high school, and

WHEREAS, the most recent priority construction list compiled under Public Law-815 program shows Alchesay High School application the third on priority with the funds commitment of \$3,551,824.00, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has always been of the opinion that the education of its youth is of prime importance to the welfare of the Apache people, and

WHEREAS, it was the Tribal Council's understanding that due to the need and severity of the youth problem on the reservation that Alchesay High School would be No. 1 priority.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe supports the local school board of Alchesay High School, District No. 20, in their effort for the construction of the much needed new high school.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe strongly desires that the construction program for Alchesay High School, District No. 20 be placed No. 1 on the Bureau of Indian Affairs school construction priority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to all congressional delegates in the State of Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
