RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Health Authority has been established to develop an effective health care delivery system for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Health Advisory Board of the Tribal Health Authority has been functioning only irregularly for one year without benefit of full-time staff and staff planning activities, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Health Authority will move into full operation now that a full-time staff has been hired and a revised contract and budget have been approved.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council extend the terms of office of Kino Edwards and Charlotte Bahlen, the two one-year appointees to the Health Advisory Board, for another one-year period in order to maintain the high level of motivation among Board members and to insure the continuation of their community support and involvement.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
