RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe continues to maintain the position that the proper education of its youth is of prime importance to the interests and welfare of the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Alchesay High School, District No. 20, Whiteriver, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, (Navajo County, Arizona), has consummated an application for sufficient funds to construct a new, much needed high school, and
- WHEREAS, the Alchesay High School Application has had first priority on the construction list compiled under the Public Law 81-815 Program, and
- WHEREAS, the severe need for better education and educational facilities for White Mountain Apache youths on the reservation requires that Alchesay High School continue its No. 1 priority.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it fully supports the local School Board of Alchesay High School, District No. 20, in its effort for the prompt construction of the much needed high school on the reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe strongly urges that the Bureau of Indian Affairs' school construction program further its recognition of the top priority of the Alchesay High School Application by taking all appropriate and necessary action to insure the construction of this No. 1 priority high school.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to all Congressional Delegates in the State of Arizona, with a request for their full support.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
