FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, West Anderson requested that his business lease at Canyon Day be modified, and


WHEREAS, he requested that the 180 day action time be eliminated, and

WHEREAS, the 180 day limit has been removed from other leases.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the 180 day limit be removed from the business lease to West Anderson dated December, 1974.

The foregoing resolution was on January 15, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
