## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 65-156 requested that the Fort Apache Compound and the Military Cemetery be nominated for the National Historical Site, and
- WHEREAS, the tribe has reviewed the contents of the resolution and wishes to request that action be initiated to fulfill that resolution, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed a documentation prepared for the nomination and is in agreement with this document, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council understands the advantages and disadvantages of the National Registration.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are authorized and directed to sign any and all documents to place this historic park nomination before the State and National Committee.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the nomination be handled with haste and it be recognized by the National Committee at the earliest possible date.

The foregoing resolution was on January 15, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
