RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the tribe has received an invitation from Housing and Urban Development to submit applications for a block grant, and
- WHEREAS, the deadline for the initial applications is February 15, 1976, and
- WHEREAS, the tribe has established priorities and request the sum of \$800,000.00, and
- WHEREAS, Priority No. 1 was Multiple Use Building in Cibecue; Priority No. 2 was the Head Start Installation; and Priority No. 3 was the Housing Improvement Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required by the Housing and Urban Development for the consummation of these grants.

The foregoing resolution was on January 15, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Secretary of the Tribal Council
