

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Western Apache Claim (Docket 22-D) has been settled, and

WHEREAS, it will be some time before the requirements for the plan will be developed, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires that their one-half of the total claim monies be invested to accumulate interest, and

WHEREAS, the estimates of six months will be a reasonable time.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that their share of (1/2) one-half of all monies from the settlement of (Claim, Docket 22-D) Western Apache be invested for a period of six (6) months.

The foregoing resolution was on January 23, 1976 adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
