RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to withdraw its membership from the Indian Development District of Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to develop and manage their own planning district, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Fort Apache Indian Reservation will be a Planning District managed by the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is requesting that their share of all Indian Development District of Arizona funding and other available funds come direct to the Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that its membership be withdrawn from the Indian Development District of Arizona and all relations forthwith be severed.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribe requests that all sources of funding going to the Indian Development District of Arizona and any other available funds be sent directly to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for management.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforementioned funds be either grant or contract.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
