RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation has plans for an asphalic concrete overlay project on State Highway 73, and
- WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department is in need of materials for construction of the above project and has requested a permit for the said materials on file in the Office of the Superintendent, Fort Apache Indian Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to issue a permit to the Arizona Highway Department for borrow materials to be used on the project, approximately 8,000 yards to be taken from Pit 7511 and 20,000 yards from Pit 7510 for widening of existing roadway.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arizona Highway Department shall pay this tribe the following rates computed on a tonnage basis for the removal of said sand and gravel: Six cents (6¢) per ton for all borrow; Ten cents (10¢) per ton for all select; Twelve cents (12¢) per ton for all ABC, MA; and Fifteen cents (15¢) per ton for all cover removed from the premises.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
