RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the \$50,000.00 fund for use on reservation roads, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council considered Oak Creek Road and McNary Community, and

WHEREAS, the Council by majority vote, voted to expend the funds at McNary.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the \$50,000.00 road fund be expended in the community of McNary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized and directed to sign any and all documents to obligate the funds and expedite the project.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for, 2 against, 1 abstained by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
