RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is going to build a shopping center complex, and

WHEREAS, the location is at the junction of the south Whiteriver Low Rent Housing and Highway 73, and

WHEREAS, the area is approximately 600 feet by 900 feet.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this area be set aside for the Tribal Shopping Center Complex.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when the land is surveyed and described, the description is to be attached to this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on February 11, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
