## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Apache Service Liquor Store is presently located in the center of town, and
- WHEREAS, the location near the Whiteriver highway often creates an extreme hazard to the safety and welfare of tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, relocating the liquor store to an area near the Apache Flame would provide a safer and more centralized location for the sale and use of liquor.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs that the Apache Service Liquor Store be relocated within ninety (90) days from the date of this resolution, to an area near the Apache Flame.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Apache Enterprise is hereby given full authority and responsibility to properly carry out the directives of this resolution.

The foreging resolution was on February 11, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
