

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the cutting extension on the following described logging units expires December 31, 1975:

Soldier Butte

CONTRACT NUMBER  
H50C-1420-6956

, and

WHEREAS, these logging units are under contract to the Fort Apache Timber Company, a Tribal Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company has requested that the contract dates be extended due to poor market conditions, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to extend these sales to allow Fort Apache Timber Company to finish cutting and perform other contract obligations, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Forestry Committee recommends approval of these extensions.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe consents to extend the cutting expiration date to December 31, 1977 and the expiration date for other sale obligations to December 31, 1978.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required.

The foregoing resolution was on February 11, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
