RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the tribe desires to apply under Public Law 93-638 for a Tribal Government Improvement Grant, and
- WHEREAS, these grant funds will be used to establish a Tribal Personnel Office and contract with the Civil Service Commission for redraft and updating of the Tribal Personnel Manual and Reservation population census, and
- WHEREAS, the estimated cost is \$50,000.00 for both the Personnel Office operation and the redraft of the Tribal Personnel Manual and Reservation population census.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Public Law 93-638 be made available for this project in the amount of \$50,000.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is autnorized and directed to sign all necessary forms for application and receipt of this grant.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this proposal is in keeping with the intent of Public Law 93-638 in improving the Tribal Government and for a prerequisite to contracting with the Bureau of Indian Affairs under the facility of Public Law 93-638.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 76-13 be rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on February 11, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
