

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has decided to establish a date for the closing of the White Mountain Apache Tribal rolls, and
- WHEREAS, this designated closing is for the distribution of share for the settlement of the Western Apache Claim Docket 22-D, and
- WHEREAS, this closing does not affect membership but will establish membership eligibility for participating in this claim distribution, and
- WHEREAS, the proposed closing date of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Roll for sharing in the Western Apache Claim is established as May 31, 1976 at midnight, and
- WHEREAS, after this closing date, no applications will be received by the White Mountain Apache Tribe for membership applications to determine eligibility in the aforementioned claim, and
- WHEREAS, notices will be made public by March 1, 1976 giving potential members within the continental United States, ninety-two (92) days to file the necessary document, and
- WHEREAS, potential members outside of the continental United States or Alaska, applications will be received until June 30, 1976, and
- WHEREAS, all requests and all applications postmarked before 12:00 o'clock midnight May 31, 1976 or June 30, 1976 must be addressed to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, P. O. Box 1158, Whiteriver, Arizona 85941, Attention: Mrs. Mary C. Endfield, Statistician.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to make a broad circulation of this notice informing potential members of the closing of the rolls for distribution of the Western Apache Claim.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that adequate copies be sent to all areas where there is a possibility of potential members living.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this notification be published in local, state and selected out-of-state newspapers for notification.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforesaid notifications be in circulation by the first day of March, 1976.

The foregoing resolution was on February 11, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
