WHEREAS, Paschal Johnson had requested permission to purchase and keep rodeo stock on the reservation, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that it would be good for recreational activities, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Johnson has agreed to keep the animals penned up and not be in conflict with Ordinance No. 31.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Johnson be permitted to purchase and maintain rodeo stock on the reservation for reservation rodeos.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
