

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, P.L. 93-638 provides for Indian Tribes to contract for services with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to apply for such a contract in the amount of \$36,000.00 to upgrade the Tribal Court System as outlined in the attached proposed budget.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized to negotiate the contract and any amendments thereto and upon completion of the negotiation process to execute the contract and any amendments thereto without further review by the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposed date of the contract commencement be January 1, 1976 for a period of six (6) months and that the expiration date of the authorizations granted by this resolution be July 1, 1976.


The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
