WHEREAS, the Canyon Day Community was allocated Revenue Sharing Funds two years ago which have not been fully expended as yet, and


WHEREAS, there is a two year time limit for the expenditure of these funds which will expire in April, 1976, and

WHEREAS, the community needs these funds to provide various services to the community, and

WHEREAS, these funds which are unexpended amount to \$10,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED that the time period for the expenditure of these funds for one year.


The foregoing resolution was on March 4, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
