

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Act of August 16, 1956 (70 Stat. 1057) authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to convey to any Indian Tribe, upon their request, title to any Federally-owned building, improvement or facility located on Indian land that is no longer required by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe cannot presently finance construction of a unit, and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Indian Agency plans to dispose of Quarters No. 52 located in NW/4 of the NW/4 of NW/4 of Section 18: TSN: R23E, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, which can be used as a Head Start unit by the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to convey to the White Mountain Apache Tribe (Quarters No. 52) aforementioned to be utilized for a Head Start unit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe accepts responsibility for adequate maintenance and proper utilization of said buildings and realizes that the Secretary of the Interior, should he determine that the property is not being adequately maintained or utilized by the White Apache Tribe, or that property creates a health or safety hazard, may declare a forfeiture or same and said property shall revert to the United States.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate the above transfer.

The foregoing resolution was on March 4, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


