RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to provide adequate and appropriate housing development for the tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, in cooperation with the Federal Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Agency, has recommended a preliminary subdivision plan for the development of the North Fork District.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approves the preliminary subdivision lot development plans as presented and recommended by the Housing Authority.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to carry out the purposes of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1976, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
