## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is interested in creating employment for its members, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs under the Buy-Indian Authority for the construction of the office expansion, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to negotiate with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for Invitation to Bid Project No. H52-FM-6-36 for the office addition project.
- BE IT RESOLVED BY the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to submit a proposal for the construction project and sign any and all documents to consummate a contract.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise be authorized to complete this project and the Chairman be authorized to sign all necessary documents to provide for management for the project.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1976, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
