RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to enter into a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to which the Tribal Council will receive, manage, and disburse Johnson O'Malley Supplemental Funds for eligible Indian children, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the Tribal Education Committee be the "Local Indian Education Committee" as for the purpose of subpart B, Section 273.15, J.O.M. Act, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the Tribal Education Office exercise the powers and obligations of the Tribal Council under the aforesaid contract with the B.I.A.,
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to enter into a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for Supplemental Johnson O'Malley Funds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Education Committee is hereby designated as the "Local Indian Education Committee" for the purposes of said contract, and that the powers and obligations of the contract shall be carried out by the Committee through the Tribal Education office.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to carry out the purposes of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1976, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
