- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee met on December 18, 1975, and
- WHEREAS, the Committee recommended to the Tribal Council, forty nine (49) individuals for adoption into the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered each of the forty nine (49) individuals recommended by the Enrollment Committee, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the forty nine (49) individuals listed be adopted into membership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that each individual listed on the attached list be adopted as members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each individual listed be placed up on the Tribal Roll.

The foregoing resolution was on May 5, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 4 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 2 of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

MINUTES OF THE

ENROLLMENT COMMITTEE

December 18, 1975

White Mountain Apache Tribe Fort Apache Indian Reservation Whiteriver, Arizona December 18, 1975 ENROLLMENT COMMITTEE MEETING

At 1:00 p.m., on the above date, the committee members began arriving and at 1:30 p.m. the meeting was called to order with the following committee members present: Mrs. Violet Zospah, Mrs. Cornelia Hoffman, Mr. Adam Lupe and Mrs. Mary C. Endfield. Also present were: Mrs. Glorianna Dayaye, and Dallas Massey from the BIA Office. McNeil Toggie, a member of the Enrollment Committee was absent.

Mrs. Endfield explained the purpose of the meeting and handed out lists of applications turned in requesting enrollment from those who do not meet the blood quantum and also children of enrolled members who do not qualify under the blood quantum. The list was gone over consecutively with Mrs. Endfield identifying each individual, where they lived, ancestors and why they did not qualify for the rolls. After going over the list, a discussion continued.

Mrs. Endfield reported that she had written to Mr. Fritz Tenijieth, the former Chairman of the Enrollment Committee, for applications that she had forwarded to him asking him to return them to her office, but to date, she has not heard from him. Also explained why some information are lacking on some of the applicants, like the Eischens, children of James Eischen. She has correspondence from Mr. Bischen and Jennifer Eischen, but no information on birthdates, ancestors, etc.

Another application from Mrs. Wilma (Kateen) Moy was questioned. Committee members felt that she was not legally married to Calvin Clay and this information should be clear before they consider these applications of her children. Members of the committee all are agreeable that applications for enrollment should be complete, especially in cases where we are not acquainted with the family.

Adam Lupe entertained a motion that he is agreeable to all the applicants with the exceptions of the Eischens (Jennifer & her brother) and Melissa Rose Clay, Melvin Sonny Clay and Clarissa Jean Clay, children of Mrs. Wilma (Kateen) Moy, further that more information be obtained on the above applicants through correspondence, their names, birth dates, ancestry, domicile, etc.; further that a proposed resolution be presented to the Tribal Council at its next meeting, together with the completed enrollment list; such as, names, birthdates, blood degrees and parents' names. Mrs. Glorianna Dayaye requested that her neice's name, Monica Harvey be added to the list as she had filed with Mr. Tenijieth for sometime now and this was accepted by the committee members and motion seconded by Mrs. Cornelia Hoffman and carried four for and none against.

The committee briefly discussed other sensitive matters involved that had been encountered that they are aware of, especially difficult to answer is how low should the tribe go on blood degrees on enrolling children from inter-marriages. Also affiliation and participation on tribal activities was briefly discussed.

Mrs. Dayaye advised the committee that the distribution of funds is now in the register and it states that those under 18 years of age will not get their judgment funds and they will be placed in the IIM Account and they will not be able to get it until they reach the age. She should hear very soon about how soon they can pay off and will need the rolls completed right away to pay off.

There being no more discussion for today, the meeting adjourned at 2:30 p.m.

Dear Mr. Ruiz:

Your letter dated August 19, 1975 to Superintendent Dye forwarded to Chairman Lupe on September 16, 1975 requesting enrollment of Melissa Rose Clay, Melvin Sonny Clay and Clarissa Jean Clay, children of Mrs. Wilma Koteen Moy.

To my recollection, Mrs. Moy never made anyapplications for her children for enrollment with me or my office. If she did, she may have done it orally with Mr. Banashley, the former Tribal Chairman.

Our Tribal Constitution says that to be eligible for enrollment, you have to be 1/2 White Mountain Apache; Calvin Clay is 3/4 White Mountain Apache and 1/4 San Carlos Apache; therefore, his children would be 3/8 White Mountain and 1/8 San Carlos Apache, and 1/2 Jicarilla if Mrs. Moy is 4/4 Jicarilla Apache. For this reason, the children could not be automatically enrolled, they had to go through the Enrollment Committee. The Enrollment Committee had not met for many months until last week, December 18, 1975.

I presented the request of Mrs. Moy to the Committee on the above date and the committee requested that this office first be furnished with a copy of the marriage certificate between Wilma and Calvin Clay, for further consideration.

The Enrollment Committee finally met on December 18, 1975, at which time your request was presented to the committee. Your application was incomplete, as the former Chairman of that committee had been replaced and he did not return all the applications that had been forwarded to him. Yours was among them.

The Committee request that your complete name at birth; date of birth; sex; natural parents, their nationalities and permanent domicile and your permanent domicile and addresses will be needed to reconsider your application. It is also important that we know if you are an adopted child or not. This would also be expected from brothers or sisters. Your father never mentioned how many children he had in his last letter. So, as soon as you can get the above information to us, we will be waiting.
