

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Annie Dawahongva requested an application for a traders permit, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has no objections to the issuance of a traders permit, and

WHEREAS, Annie Dawahongva is going to operate a curio shop in her home adjacent to Fort Apache, Arizona.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mrs. Annie Dawahongva be issued a traders permit and that all tribal fees be waived.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required for the traders permit.

The foregoing resolution was on May 5, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
