## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there is a vacancy in the position of Associate Judge which the Tribal Council is authorized to fill under Ordinance No. 98, and
- WHEREAS, George Garland has qualified and been recommended by the Law and Order Committee for the position of Associate Judge, and
- WHEREAS, George Garland accepts the appointment, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the starting salary of \$8,500.00 as equitable.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby appoints George Garland to fill the position of Associate Judge of the Tribal Court, effective May 10, 1976 until the next election unless otherwise removed by law.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Associate Judge shall be under the supervision of the Chief Judge of the Tribal Court.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the per diem rate for the Associate Judge is established as the same rate for other tribal employees.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the council authorizes and directs the Chairman to sign the Tribal Form E and be the approving official for traveling request and per diem for the Associate Judge.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Associate Judge Position is subject to all tribal fringe benefits now or hereafter provided by the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 5, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Consitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
