RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Section 17.4 of the Law and Order Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe provides for the licensing of Attorneys and Counselors in the Tribal Court, and
- WHEREAS, the attached Standards for Licensing Attorneys and Counselors are recommended by the Law and Order Committee, and are approved, and
- WHEREAS, the Law and Order Code provides for a Licensing Fee which is to be paid upon application for the license to practice, and which is to be approved by the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Standards attached hereto are recommended for approval by the Chief Judge.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a Licensing Fee in the amount of \$50.00 per year shall be paid for each license to practice before Tribal Courts of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; provided that no Licensing Fee shall be required of tribal members making application for a license to practice before the Tribal Courts.

The foregoing resolution was on May 5, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
