- WHEREAS, there is a minor volume of logs from construction at McNary and Hon-Dah, and
- WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company does not want to pick up these logs because of the small size, the small volume, and the nails and other debris in these logs.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Permit Policy for Calendar Year, 1976 be amended to permit the Forestry Branch to issue a permit at \$5.00/thousand gross log scale for these logs.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized and directed to sign the necessary documents to complete the contract.

The foregoing resolution was on May 6, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Pursuant to the authority invested in me under Section 17.4 of the Law and Order Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and upon the recommendation of the Tribal Law and Order Committee, I hereby declare and establish that the following requirements must be met by lay and professional counselors who desire a license to practice before the Tribal Courts of the White Mountain Apache Tribe:

- A completed application of the prescribed forms must be submitted to the Court;
- 2. A signed affidavit must be submitted which contains an avowal to the Court that the applicant is of good moral character, has not been convicted of a felony, has not been found in contempt of court by a Tribal Court, and that he/she will notify the Chief Judge in the event he/she is convicted of a felony, disbarred by a State Court or is found in contempt of Court by a Tribal Court;
- 3. The applicant must avow under oath that he/she will only engage in conduct becoming an officer of the Court, and maintain a continuing professional familiarity with the constitution, amendments and Law and Order Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- 4. A fee as determined by the Tribal Council shall be submitted with the application payable to the Clerk of the Tribal Court.
