

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to receive a grant for the Home Improvement Program, and

WHEREAS, the council has successfully managed the Home Improvement Program for the past three years, and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent has informed the council that for the Fiscal Year 1976, there is approximately \$60,000.00 available for the Home Improvement Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Bureau of Indian Affairs make a grant to the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the amount of \$60,000.00 for the tribe to manage and develop the Housing Improvement Program for the Fiscal Year 1976.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies available in this grant be used for supplies and materials and the labor is to be furnished by the Tribal Work Experience Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents to consummate the grant.

The foregoing resolution was on May 6, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
