## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is interested in creating local employment, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has three (3) small construction jobs pending,
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to contract these jobs under the Buy-Indian Authority, and
- WHEREAS, the proposed projects are at the John F. Kennedy School, the Whiteriver Sewer lift plant and the Agency Spring Supply development, and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that these projects be negotiated under the Buy-Indian Authority.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe submit a proposal for the construction of these projects and be granted permission by the Bureau of Indian Affairs to negotiate for the completed contract.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be directed and authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to consumate the contract.

The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
