## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe shall receive approximately \$83,762.00 as its allocation of Federal Revenue Sharing Funds for July 1 through December 1, 1976, and
- WHEREAS, Federal Law requires that the Tribe specify which use or uses it intends to designate these funds, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is deeply concerned about the Tribe's responsibility for the care and development of its young people, particularly regarding the creation of productive activities and alternatives to juvenile problems on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware that presently there are no youth facilities on the reservation for the young people, through which they could direct their young energies, ambitions and talents.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby designates the \$83,762.00 Revenue Sharing Funds for use in the creation of youth recreational facilities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1976duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
