RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the status of the Land Claims for Docket 22-D, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council deems it necessary to re-activate the Land Claims Planning Committee, and
- WHEREAS, Raymond Endfield, Jr. is reappointed as Chairman of the Committee, and
- WHEREAS, the Land Claims Committee is to assist the Tribal Council in all phases of planning for and final disposition of Docket 22-D.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Raymond Endfield, Jr. be appointed as Chairman of the Land Claims Committee until final disposition of the claim of Docket 22-D.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Land Claims Committee serve in all phases of the planning for the disposition of Docket 22-D and freely advise the Tribal Council of the needs, desires and requirements of the White Mountain Apache people.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
