RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, in order for the White Mountain Apache Tribe to qualify for the benefits of a Redevelopment District under the requirements of the Economic Development Administration, an Overall Economic Development Plan (OEDP) must be organized for Economic Development Administration approval, and
- WHEREAS, the current Overal Economic Development Plan is outdated and Economic Development Administration has specified that a new one must be compiled in order to continue qualification, and
- WHEREAS, the goals and priorities for overall development of the Reservation must be determined by the people themselves, as represented by a committee selected by the Tribal Council, and entitled the "OEDP Committee."
- BE IT RESOLVED that the following individuals are hereby appointed as members of the OEDP Committee and authorized to create an Overall Economic Development Plan to fulfill Economic Development Administration requirements:
