

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the operation of the Apache Flame, and  
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to establish new hours of operation to be  
enforced at the Apache Flame until further notice.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that operating  
hours at the Apache Flame will be as follows:

TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY, FRIDAY of each week, the operating  
hours will be 5:00 p.m. until MIDNIGHT

On SATURDAY of each week, the operating hours will be from 12:00  
Noon to 1:00 A.M.

Each SUNDAY AND MONDAY, the Apache Flame will be closed without making  
sales or without opening.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this review and action taken by the Tribal Council  
is felt to be in the best interest of all reservation residents.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for  
and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant  
to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution  
and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the  
Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
