## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe will be contracting for the Johnson O'Malley Funds for Fiscal Year, 1977, and
- WHEREAS, in order to best serve the needs and interest of the White Mountain Apache students attending the Mission and Bureau of Indian Affairs schools, it is essential that the student eligibility provision of Title II Education Act of Section 273.12 of the Johnson O'Malley Regulations be waived, and
- WHEREAS, the Mission and Bureau school students will be allowed to participate in Tribal Work-Study Summer Program which otherwise cannot be fulfilled.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council does hereby request the Commissioner of the Bureau of Indian Affairs immediately to waive the provision of Section 273.12 of the Johnson O'Malley Regulations pertaining to the eligibility of Indian students attending the Mission and Bureau of Indian Affairs Schools.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
