

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Housing Authority was established in the interests of creating housing for tribal members on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, said Housing Authority is financed through the federal agency of Housing and Urban Development, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is deeply interested in assuring that the Housing Authority is operated in a business like manner and in the best interests of the White Mountain Apache people.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby respectfully requests and invites Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to undertake a complete audit of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Housing Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council requests that a copy of the audit results be provided to the Chairman of the Tribal Council as soon as possible after the audit is completed.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 7, 1976, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
