

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Forestry and Lands Committee have made recommendations to the Council on the proposed changes of the Rim Road, and

WHEREAS, it will affect 831 feet of Rim Road on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Forest Service has agreed to move 4886 feet of the Rim Road off of the reservation and leave 4949 feet remaining on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Rim Road will be closed to all traffic in Section 16, and

WHEREAS, starting at the west end of Wagon Wheel Road at AP 372, leave the road on the reservation up to AP 74, and

WHEREAS, the Forest Service will install two (2) cattleguards to maintain the integrity of the fence line, and

WHEREAS, due to steep topography on the forest side of the boundary, leave the road on the reservation from AP 387 to AP 397, and

WHEREAS, all other places where the Rim Road is on the reservation, the Forest Service will move it onto the National Forest Land.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Rim Road be closed at Section 16 to all traffic and from the west end of Wagon Wheel Road at AP 372, leave the road on the reservation up to AP 374, the length of this section is 1,287 feet.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that due to steep topography in the forest side of the boundary, leave the Rim Road on the reservation from AP 387 to AP 397. This distance is 3,658 feet.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all places where the Rim Road is on the reservation, the tribe is in agreement that the Forest Service shall move onto the National Forest.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the tribe understands that all work involved will be done by the National Forest Service in September and October of 1976.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to Authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
