RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation has requested that the Tribe renew the Revocable Permit for the Flying V Maintenance Camp, and
- WHEREAS, Arizona Department of Transportation requested the Tribe to consider a five-year Revocable Permit at a rate of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per year, and
- WHEREAS, after much deliberation, the Council agrees to issue a new Revocable Permit for a five-year period at the rate of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars per year.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and Superintendent are authorized and directed to issue a new Revocable Permit for the Flying V Maintenance Camp for a five-year period at a fee of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars per year.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the tribe requires that the State Highway employees will not trespass beyond the boundaries of the permit area.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
