

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Adam Lupe, Sr., Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair Commission, has requested a Fine Arts Exhibit Building, and

WHEREAS, the cost of the building is approximately \$8,500.00, and

WHEREAS, the building would be constructed of slump block, 18 x 36 feet, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with the need of a Fine Arts Building to encourage Fine Arts participation among the young and old members alike.

D. RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$8,500.00 be used from Contingency funds for the construction of the Fine Arts Building for the Fair Grounds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this investment by the White Mountain Apache Tribe is being made to encourage all White Mountain Apache members to exercise their skills and display their Fine Arts project in order to encourage fine arts development upon the reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized to expend these funds for the benefit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
