

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the request of the Cibecue Community for a vehicle for use for general community purposes, and

WHEREAS, a truck is necessary to the Cibecue Community for such purposes, in the best interests and welfare of the community, and

WHEREAS, some funds have been saved by the Cibecue Community, but are inadequate to purchase the needed truck, and the community has requested the financial assistance of the Central Tribe.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby grants to the Cibecue Community funds not in excess of \$5,000.00 on a matching fund basis, to be used for the purpose of purchasing a truck for general community use.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes a budget amendment for such funding as is authorized by this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$5,000.00 budget increase be appropriated from funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized to sign any and all documents to consummate the budget amendment.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
