RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHERFAS, the Claims Committee has screened a number of applicants for the position of Recreation Director required in the settlement of Docket 22-D, and
- WHEREAS, the Claims Committee recommended the appointment of Miss Genevieve Endfield, and
- WHEREAS, this appointment will have a starting salary of \$13,000.00 per year.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Miss Genevieve Endfield is appointed as Recreation Director as required in the settlement of Docket 22-D at a salary of \$13,000.00 per year.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salary and office expenses be paid from this current tribal budget out of funds programmed in the tribal budget to be reimbursed from the settlement of Docket 22-D.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that besides meeting the requirements established in the settlement of Docket 22-D, the Recreation Director shall have the responsibility of hiring needed employees and maintaining a program file for the benefit of the Claims Committee and the Tribal Council.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the starting date for this position be on August 16, 1976.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
