## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is starting to put a membership rolls on the Bureau of Indian Affairs computer in Albuquerque, New Mexico, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal rolls containing valuable and confidential information, and
- WHEREAS, it is the concern of the Tribal Council that this roll information never be released to unauthorized persons.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the operators and responsible people of the Bureau of Indian Affairs Computer Center never release this information to unauthorized people.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council request that any information contained in the tribal roll be released only with the written permission of the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on August 11, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
