WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise has proposed to the Tribal Council the boundaries on the I.D. Game Preserve be re-established and fenced, and


WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Tribal Council that for the protection of the wildlife resource, that this area be set aside as a preserve.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the attached map that delineates the I.D. Game Preserve be accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the responsibility of the Recreation Enterprise to post and appropriately mark this boundary for easy identification for the management of the game preserve.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
