## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the tribal members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation are in need of additional housing, and
- WHEREAS, the shortage of housing can only be relieved by additional housing through the Housing and Urban Development assistance.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Housing Authority apply for an additional 100 Mutual Help Homes and 50 rental units.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to initiate the request and sign any and all documents to secure the additional 150 housing units.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
