WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company is a Tribal Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs purchases lumber on contract from
off of the reservation, and

WHEREAS, many of the wood products purchased are available from the Fort
Apache Timber Company.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe
that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Agency purchase from the
Fort Apache Timber Company, those wood products available.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of
9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the
Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27,
1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
