FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the McNary Service Station has a new owner, and

WHEREAS, Grobin Davis has applied for Traders permit to operate a service station and garage for the McNary town.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent and the Tribal Chairman issue a Traders Permit and Tribal Business Permit to Grobin Davis.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
