

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been notified that there is \$32,500.00 available for Law Enforcement Planning, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is interested in contracting under Public Law 93-638 for the responsibility of conducting the study, and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it desires to contract for this Law Enforcement Planning for the amount of \$32,500.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the Tribe's understanding that it would furnish all personnel supplies, materials to conduct a survey of the existing needs of the reservation courts, police and detention program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to negotiate for this contract and any required amendments.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to execute the contract in the amendments required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the expiration date of the authority grant by this resolution will be the proposed termination date of the contract, December 31, 1976.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a contract review of the contract and amendments and progress be made with the Tribal Governing Body before execution and thereafter at 90-day intervals. A proposed starting date for the contract, if granted, September 1, 1976 and the end of the contract is proposed to be December 31, 1976.


The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
