


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on August 12, 1976, the Tribal Council passed Resolution No. 76-135, and  
WHEREAS, the stipulation of Buy Indian Authority was left from the resolution.  
BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that  
Resolution No. 76-135 be amended to read:

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for the procurement of other  
product available from the Fort Apache Timber Company,  
that the Buy Indian Authority be used."

The foregoing resolution was on September 8, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10  
for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,  
pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended  
Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and  
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section  
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
