RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is constructing and developing the Whiteriver Commercial Center for the development of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to have established within said Commercial Center a new expanded U. S. Post Office, and
- WHEREAS, the U. S. Postal Service has submitted a proposed Agreement to Lease at the rate of \$14,325.00 per year rental, and
- WHEREAS, said rental offer is fair and equitable in the interests of the economic as well as the postal services concerns of the tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the U. S. Postal Service is hereby granted a lease at the rate of \$14,325.00 per year for a ten-year term, with three, five-year options for renewal.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent and the Chairman are hereby authorized and directed to execute a standard lease including the above terms and conditions.

The foregoing resolution was on September 8, 1976 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
